Agreement with CCTL	

1. GENERAL

This is an agreement between Indian CC Certification Scheme, Ministry of Electronics & Information Technology, Government of India, hereinafter referred to as Certification Body (CB), located at CC Certification Body, Indian Common Criteria Certification Scheme (IC3S), STQC Directorate, Electronics Niketan, 6 CGO Complex, Lodi Road, New Delhi 110003, India

and

hereinafter referred to as the CCTL, working at:

2. CCTL Enlistment REQUIREMENTS

Labs to be enlisted as CCTL shall meet the requirement as specified in document STQC/CC/D04 "Requirements for Testing Laboratories".

CCTL shall, prior to applying for enlistment shall be accredited by independent agency for being compliant against ISO/IEC 17025.

Certification Body will on a regular basis check the above compliance by document review and site visit if deemed fit.

3. RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE CCTL

The CCTL shall at all times perform evaluation activities in accordance with the appropriate CB procedures, instructions and guidance notes.

The Evaluator in CCTL will under no circumstances perform evaluation activities for CCTL of a product for whom he/she has acted in any consulting capacity during the previous two years. The CCTL is responsible for advising CB immediately should such a situation arise.

The CCTL shall maintain all documentation provided to it by Applicant organisation as strictly confidential and shall not, without prior consent of Applicant, allow such documents to be copied or to be provided to any third party.

4. RESPONSIBILITIES OF CB

CB shall on each occasion formally request the services of the CCTL for evaluation activities.

CB shall provide to the CCTL all relevant and necessary procedures, instructions, guidance notes, standard forms, etc., as per STQC/CC/D08, D09 for the performance of the evaluation activities.

5. TERMINATION

Either party may terminate this agreement giving three months' notice in writing of intent to terminate.

CB reserves the right to terminate unilaterally and without notice should it find that the conduct of the CCTL is not in compliance with the stipulations of this Agreement, or has brought or is likely to bring CB into disrepute, or where there is evidence of incompetence relating to the Evaluator's CC activities.

6. FORCE MAJEURE

Either party shall be relieved from their obligations under this Agreement in the case that is unable to fulfil its obligations as a result of any event beyond the reasonable control of the party concerned.

7. LAW

This agreement is governed in accordance with the Laws of India.

8. CONFIDENTIALITY

Any document or information of any kind provided to the CCTL by an applicant organization either directly or via CB for the purpose of CC activities, shall be treated by the CCTL as strictly confidential and he/she shall not, other than as required by law, disclose any such information to any third party without prior written consent of the applicant organization.

9. DISPUTE RESOLUTION

In case of any disagreement between CCTL, CB & Sponsor/Developer then matter shall be brought before the Management Committee, Advisory Board. If agreement is still not reached, then Chairman Advisory Board decision shall be final.
